ANNOUNCEMENT POWER GENERATION FOR MAY 2026

This announcement is made pursuant to Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited and Inside Information Provisions under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Cap. 571, Laws of Hong Kong).

The power generation of China Longyuan Power Group Corporation Limited* (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, collectively the “**Group**”) for May 2026 on a consolidated basis amounted to 6,761,502 MWh, representing a year-on-year increase of 1.24% as compared with the corresponding period of 2025. During the month, the wind power generation registered a year-on-year decrease of 2.18%, and solar power generation registered a year-on-year increase of 17.94%.

As of 31 May 2026, the cumulative power generation of the Company for 2026 amounted to 33,433,987 MWh, representing a year-on-year decrease of 1.29% as compared with the corresponding period of 2025, of which the wind power generation registered a year-on-year decrease of 6.22% and solar power generation registered a year-on-year increase of 29.13%.

Details of the power generation of the Group for May 2026 are set out as follows:
